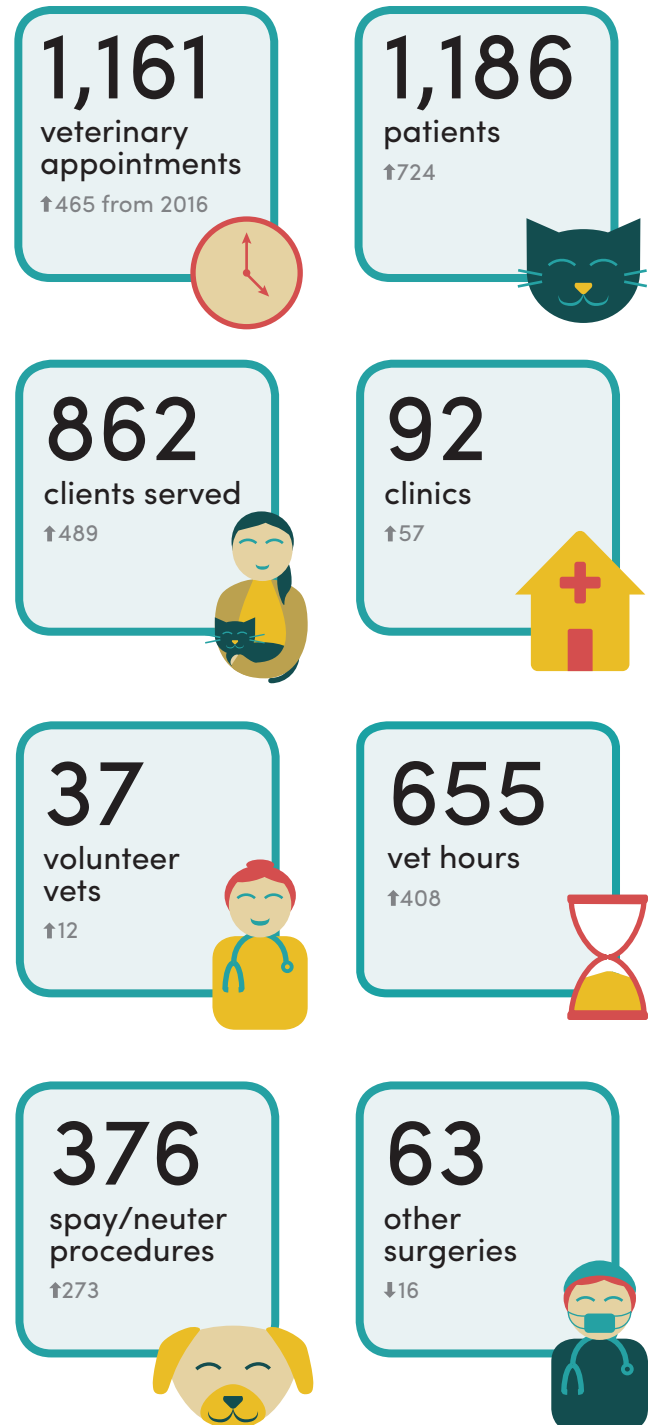
Our Vision

2017 by the Numbers

Thanks to an immense amount of community support, 2017 was a remarkable year for PAW Team. First, we moved to a permanent location that is more accessible to our clients and the community. We now have space for three exam tables, a fully stocked food bank and supply room, and a fully functioning pharmacy. Second, we more than doubled the number of pets and families helped in 2017 compared to 2016. And finally, we added a full-time staff position, allowing us to better meet the ever-growing demand for our services.

PAW Team thrives in large part due to our community partnerships. In 2017 we established a partnership with the Oregon Humane Society to provide over 350 spay/neuter surgeries for the pets of our clients. Our spay/neuter program is also made possible by our close partnership with Animal Aid, which provides funding for the program. In addition, we vastly improved our referral program, which allows over 40 social service agencies to refer clients directly to us. These organizations include Central City Concern, JOIN, Transition Projects, Inc., Home Forward, and Bradley Angle House.



Financial Information

Thanks to generous support from a growing number of individuals, foundations, and businesses, PAW Team's revenue increased by roughly 50% over 2016, to a total of \$255,677. As a result, PAW Team was able to significantly expand the number of people and pets served, launch a transportation service to help people keep important appointments, and purchase needed medical supplies.

None of our work would be possible without the support of generous community members and grant-making organizations. Thank you to everyone who helped make 2017 a record-breaking year for PAW Team.
